Dear Silver Shekel Residents:

Please let us know if you have any information that would help find the owner of two dogs that attacked another dog. The attack resulted in injury to a Silver Shekel resident, Nick Teverbaugh, the owner of the dog that was attacked. Here are the details:

Mid-morning on Tuesday, May 30, while walking his dog Lexi near 300-400 Shekel Lane, Nick met a lady with two dogs. She was holding one black and white dog on a leash and the other brown dog was running free dragging its leash. Both appeared to be about 40 pounds. The free one approached Lexi and seemed friendly until it attacked. The lady called her free dog and came over to try to get it. However, her other dog was then in range and also went after Lexi. In trying to separate the dogs, Nick tripped and fell, hitting his right elbow. He got up and focussed on getting Lexi away from the two dogs. He didn't get the lady's contact information and didn't recognize her or the dogs. She apologized several times and asked if he was OK, but he didn't know at the time.

When Nick got home and removed his jacket, he discovered a large "bursa" on his elbow (see picture). X-rays confirmed that the elbow was broken. He had surgery on Friday and is now looking at about a six month recovery. A post-surgery picture of Nick and a picture of Lexi are attached, in case the owner sees this email recognizes him or his dog.

If you know who the lady is or recognize the vague description of the dogs, please respond to this email.
