Attempted Break in.

I wanted to also share with you what occurred Monday night, July 10. At about 11:45 our dog, Louie, started barking, which is very odd for him. He doesn't even bark when the UPS man comes. I went downstairs thinking he was telling me something was wrong with our older dog, Oz who is sick.

But the Oz was okay. Louie then laid right next to the front door. Also, not behavior that is normal. I looked outside, figured a Mook was outside and went back to bed. A few minutes latter Lou barked again, so I went downstairs again nothing. But then he went crazy. I then heard sounds on our back deck, so I pulled back the curtains and turned on the deck light and there was a man about 9" trying to open our back door. I pounded on the window, and he left. We called the police they search and did not find him. He was not just a drunk lost, because he intentionally dodged the ring camera, which means he climbed over our deck railing and had climb over a doggie gate on the deck.
